

Waiver of Responsibility and Releases for Minors Under Age 18

CodeCamp: Bridgerland 2026 · July 10–11, 2026 · Bridgerland Technical College, Logan, Utah

We hereby request that our child _____ be permitted to take part in CodeCamp: Bridgerland 2026.

I understand that participation in this activity will involve a computer programming competition held in person at Bridgerland Technical College in Logan, Utah, beginning at **8:00 AM on July 10, 2026** and ending no later than **8:00 PM on July 11, 2026**. The event does not include overnight participation, and minors are not permitted to remain at the venue outside of posted event hours.

Since my child is under 18, I understand that an on-site chaperone (age 18 or older, designated below) must be present at the venue for the entire time my child is attending the event. The chaperone may be a parent, legal guardian, or another responsible adult designated in writing by the parent or legal guardian. Regardless of who serves as chaperone, the parent or legal guardian signing this waiver remains legally responsible for the child.

Since the activity has a zero tolerance for misbehavior of any type, I provide my phone number below in the event that my child misbehaves. I agree to come and collect my child from the on-site venue, or to ensure the designated chaperone does so, if requested by event staff at any time.

Driving Policy

Individuals or teams under 18 are not permitted to drive themselves to or from the event. Accepting this agreement means you understand and agree to this. Transportation to and from the venue is the responsibility of the parent, legal guardian, or designated chaperone.

Wristband Policy

All participants under 18 will be issued a yellow wristband at check-in, which must be worn for the duration of the event. The wristband helps event staff, mentors, and volunteers identify minors so the chaperone requirement and safety policies can be upheld.

Photo Release

Bridgerland Hackathon Planning Committee and the CodeCamp: Bridgerland team reserve the right to use any photograph and/or video taken at or in conjunction with the event, without the expressed written permission of those included within the photograph or video. This includes, but is not limited to, photos and/or video captured at the on-site venue, during the event itself, or at any pre-event or related in-person meetings.

Bridgerland Hackathon Planning Committee and the CodeCamp: Bridgerland team may use, edit, alter, copy, exhibit, publish, or distribute the photographs and/or videos for any purpose that works to achieve the group's aims. This might include, but is not limited to, preparation of awards, fundraising, publicity, or in publications or other media material produced, used, or contracted by the Bridgerland Hackathon Planning Committee and the CodeCamp: Bridgerland team — including brochures, invitations, books, newspapers, magazines, television, websites, and similar — or for any other lawful purpose. You also waive the right to inspect or approve the finished product, including written or digital copy, wherein your child's likeness appears.

Since participation in this event is voluntary, you will receive no financial compensation for any use of any such photographs, videos, or other likeness.

A person attending a Bridgerland Hackathon Planning Committee or CodeCamp: Bridgerland event who does not wish to have their image recorded for distribution should make their wishes known, in writing, at the time of sign-in, and include a photograph. The committee will use that photo for identification purposes and will hold it in confidence.

By participating in this event, or by failing to notify the Bridgerland Hackathon Planning Committee and the CodeCamp: Bridgerland team in writing of your desire to not have your child's photograph or video used, you are agreeing to release, defend, hold harmless, and indemnify the Bridgerland Hackathon Planning Committee and the CodeCamp: Bridgerland team from any and all claims involving the use of any video, picture, or other likeness in which your child may appear in whole or in part. You irrevocably agree to hold harmless and release and forever discharge the Bridgerland Hackathon Planning Committee and the CodeCamp: Bridgerland team from all claims, demands, and causes of action which you, your child, your heirs, representatives, executors, administrators, or any other persons acting on your behalf or on the behalf of your estate have or may have by reason of this authorization.
